1. The University provides funding as an individual grant contribution and travel grant to the participant selected in the recruitment procedure at the following rates:

	Individual grant contribution (towards subsistence costs in host country)	Travel grant
Student mobility from the third country not associated with programme to Poland	800 EUR per month	As per distance calculator*
Student mobility from Poland to the third country not associated with programme	700 EUR per month	As per distance calculator*

2. Students/Ph.D. students are also eligible for travel grants. The amount of the travel grant depends on the distance, which the participant must travel from mobility origin to mobility destination. To calculate the distance, the University uses the online tool on the EC's website:

Travel grant will be provided at the following rates:

***green travel* is the travel within 100 -3999 km distance done via ecological means of transport, that it is: **bus, train, carpooling** (at least two people travelling together in a car belonging to one of them on the same route and for the same purpose). At least 51% of the whole route needs to be done via

3. The total mobility grant is calculated by multiplying the number of months by the rate applicable to a given country. In the case of an incomplete month, the grant amount will be calculated by multiplying the number of days in the incomplete month by 1/30 (one thirtieth) of the grant amount.
4. It is not possible to decrease or increase the level of grants within the same project to the amount announced by the National Agency.
5. Within 30 calendar days after the signature of the financial agreement between the beneficiary and the Erasmus+ mobility participant by both parties, the outgoing student will be paid 90% of the individual support and 100% of the travel lump sum specified in the agreement.
6. After providing the required documents by the outgoing student, i.e. Confirmation of Erasmus Study Period, Transcript of Records and submitting an individual report in the EU survey online system, the outgoing student will be paid the remaining amount of the grant, if applicable.
7. The incoming student will receive 100% of individual support and 100% support for travel costs at the appropriate time upon arrival at the host organization. In duly justified cases, the organization can make an individual decision of transferring to the participant the travel support before arrival. Nevertheless, the remaining part of the scholarship, for individual support, will be paid in a timely manner after the participant's arrival at the receiving institution.
8. The University guarantees payment of grants for the maximum period stipulated in the agreement.
9. If the difference in the number of days of student mobility confirmed by the host institution on *The Confirmation of Erasmus study period* is more than 5 days when compared to the study period stipulated in the agreement, participants will be required to **reimburse** the grant amount proportionally.
10. If the mobility period confirmed by the host institution is shorter by exactly 5 days or less compared to the period stipulated in the agreement or in an annex to the agreement, participants will not be required to reimburse any part of the grant amount.
11. The total mobility period abroad (mobility capital) at a given study programme under Erasmus+ may not be longer than 12 months or 24 months in the case of long-cycle degree programme.
12. It is not possible to extend the mobility period.
