UNIVERSITY PRINCIPLES FOR THE ORGANISATION AND FUNDING OF BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMMES (BIP)

BIPs are short intensive blended learning, teaching and training programmes, including online collaboration, for students and staff. Programmes can include challenge-based learning where international teams work together to address, for example, challenges related to the UN Sustainable Development Goals (<https://www.un.org.pl/>) or other societal challenges faced by specific regions, cities, businesses.

1. Eligibility criteria for the organisation of intensive courses:

- a. BIP must be developed and implemented by at least three ECHE-awarded higher education institutions from at least three programme countries. Participants from partner countries may take part but do not count towards the minimum requirements;
- b. BIP must consist of short-term physical mobility abroad (5 to 30 days), combined with a compulsory virtual component, enabling teamwork and exchange of experiences on the basis of collaborative e-learning;
- c. BIP must provide students with at least 3 ECTS credits;
- d. The duration of the virtual component is not specified;
- e. The minimum number of participants in the BIP must be 15 (not including staff involved in the programme and students from the university organising the BIP);
- f. BIP must end by the duration of the Erasmus+ financial agreement under which it is implemented.

2. As part of the allocated funding, a call for proposals for the organisation of four intensive courses is being announced. Faculties of Adam Mickiewicz University interested in organising BIPs can submit applications for BIP funding.

3. The application will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- a. application complete, submitted by the deadline;
- b. application meets the eligibility requirements for the organisation of intensive courses;

4. Detailed eligibility criteria and deadlines related to the recruitment process for the organization of Blended Intensive Programmes (BIP) under the Erasmus+ KA131 agreement will be announced during the call of proposal.
